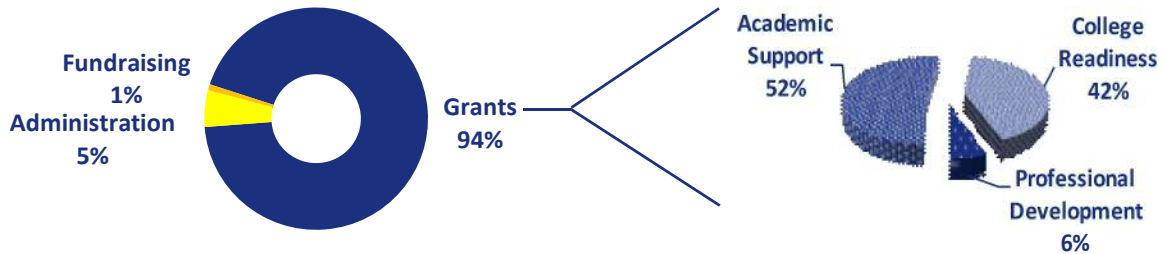

What did we do?

In FY2018, Foundation grants totaling \$197,235, or 94% of its total outlay, funded a continuum of year-round **academic support (52%)** and **college readiness (42%)** programs for students as well as **professional development (6%)** opportunities for teachers and staff. Since its start in 1995, the Foundation has provided \$2.6 million in grants for programs and school initiatives that help ensure all students at B-CC gain the skills they need to flourish and succeed.

- **Academic Support grants** funded *Summer Programs* to help students be better prepared for the school year ahead, such as the 9th and 10th Grade Summer Academies, the Pre-AP/IB Summer Enrichment Camps for rising 10th and 11th graders, and the ESOL Summer Enrichment workshop. These grants also funded *School Year Programs*, such as TAP, which provides after-school academic support for all students, and teacher-led special initiatives in the classrooms.

- **College Readiness grants** funded programs such as *CollegeTracks* which helps expand post-secondary options for students who lack financial resources and experienced adults to guide them outside school, and the *Summer College Essay Writing Workshop* which provides teacher and peer support in essay writing.

- **Professional Development grants** funded speakers and materials for in-school staff training on transformative teaching and learning and on teaching tolerance, and funded staff's attendance at workshops and national conferences.

Helping our students — A few examples:

- **TAP** — B-CC students in all grades get free after-school academic help 3 days a week in 4 core academic subjects (English, Math, Science, and Social Studies) at all levels from B-CC teachers in those disciplines. During the 2017-18 school year, **525 B-CC students** made **over 1,900 visits** to TAP: 70% were by 10th and 11th graders; 56% were by Black, Hispanic, Asian, and Multi-racial students; 42% were by White students; 18% were by students in the FARMs program; and 23% were by students who were academic-ineligible for extracurricular activities during one or more quarters.

- **Summer Academy** — **70 academically at-risk rising 9th and 10th graders** participated in the 9th and 10th grade Summer Academy Program this past summer, building the academic and leadership skills they needed to succeed in the school year ahead.

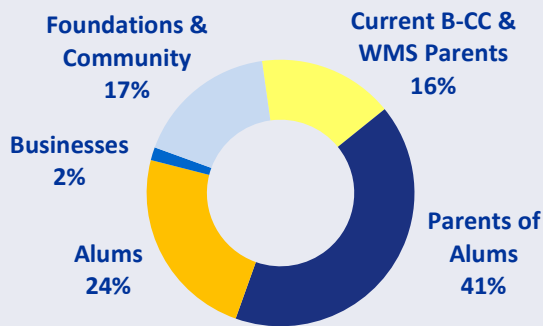
- **CollegeTracks** — this past year, **122 seniors and 86 juniors** at B-CC were mentored through the college preparation and admissions/financial aid application process, and **193 B-CC CollegeTracks graduates** at 32 colleges received guidance and support, learning critical college-success skills from CollegeTracks coaches. Of the 122 seniors, 98% were admitted to at least one of the 325 colleges and technical schools they applied to. The B-CC CollegeTracks students were predominantly minority (89%), low-income (75%), non-native English speakers (72%), and first-generation in U.S. (75%).

Foundation Revenues FY2018

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, the Foundation's net revenue reached \$201,707 in FY2018, bringing the total funds raised to more than \$2.9 million since its start in 1995.

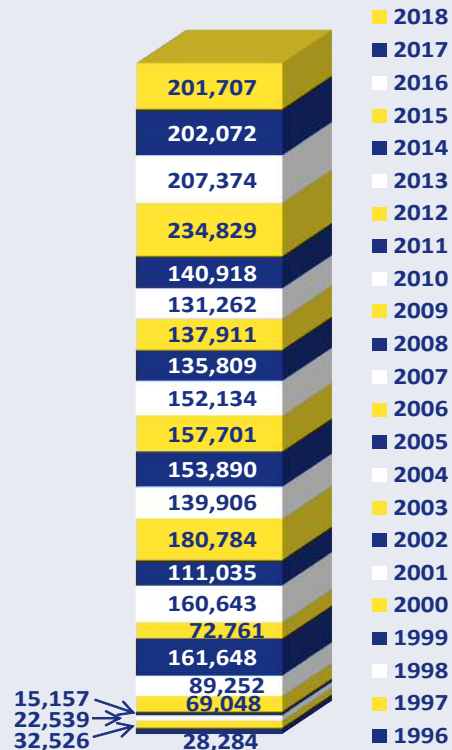

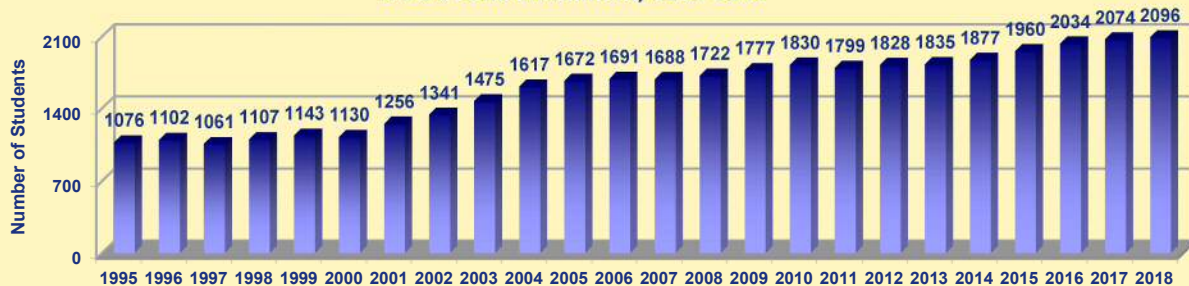
B-CC Numbers

Between 1995 and 2018, student enrollment at B-CC High School almost doubled, from 1,076 students in 1995 to 2,096 students by June 2018. The school remains racially, ethnically, and economically diverse.

In the 2017-18 school year:

- 57% of its students were Caucasian, 18% Hispanic, 14% Black, 5% Asian/Pacific Islander, and 6% Multi-racial. 70 countries were represented.
- 13% of its students qualified for the free- and reduced-price meals (FARMS) program and another 10% had been in the program in past years.
- 6% of its students were in the ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) program.
- 92% of its students were enrolled in honors, AP, IB, and other College-level courses.
- 96% of its seniors were in at least one AP/IB course.
- The IB diploma program had 136 diploma students and 178 certificate students.
- 84% of the Class of 2018 went to 4-year colleges and 13% to 2-year colleges.

The Foundation is very grateful for the generosity of our B-CC alums.

In FY2018, the Class of 1955 and the Class of 1964 donated the remainder of their reunion funds, \$1,901.13 and \$3,231.76 respectively, to the Foundation. Commemorating their 50th reunion, the Class of 1968 donated \$1,200 to the Foundation.
