Project Lead the Way (PLTW)



The Foundation continues to invest in STEM-related programs and partnerships. Project Lead the Way participation is up nearly 300% year-over-year among B-CC students.

Project Lead The Way is a nationally recognized program whereby students develop in-demand, transportable skills — such as problem solving, critical and creative thinking, collaboration, and communication — that they will use both in school and for the rest of their lives, on any career path they take. 
As B-CC continues to grow, the student body projections point to still-rising needs.

B-CC Demographics


Between 60 and 70 countries have been represented at B-CC in recent years.



Grants Outlay by Categories


